Trinity Sunday Fine Seander to Church

Gordon came 29th Royal Oak Day or
Oak-Apple Day Rained Heavy Thunder
and lightning and 2 Heavy showers of hail

wind east and West began to cut some of
the Stove Wood Fernandez crossed for the Mail
Windy Carlo to the lower point 30th Fine

Windy sawing and chopping and splitting
Stove Wood Bad with pains to Day
Cool 31st Last Day of May very Fine

Sawing Stove Wood splitting Drove the
logs out of the Grove Lots of Boats
Going to Day Harrowed the last Potatoes
