Mr James Cameron Island July

1st Sunday Went to Christies a Summer here
 2nd for his horse London I and Bob on horse
 3rd Ma-ho-ta-ta on ca-chon-tota & Alexis Talamon
 4th Went to the Bush for Berries & Lima Beans
 5th Gordon Bob & I got 3 Blank on the Island
 6th Last Day of July Moving Below the Garden
 7th Very thin the day Bob broke the Point of turn
 8th at the fishing began to take the top dip of
 9th the Potatoes now it was only Rooting them
 10th at here and there Before this they were in
 11th to the chokes chimes during eating cucumbers &c

1st of August on LAMM Island Day
 2nd putting coconuts put in 17 coils of hay small
 3rd in coconuts setting brush heaps on fire
 4th in the day Birth Day put in 7 coils of hay
 5th The first awful warm thunder last night very
 6th Boats cutting a little Bob shot 2 Ducks
 7th Thet some more heaps of brush on fire 3rd
 8th cutting on the lower Point I went to the Thorpe
 9th Da Bright 3 pecks of salt 1/3 paid pens & 8 holes 1/3
 10th us to work of the day Paid Bought a Lima Bean 1/6
 11th to Bob & Mary 1/6 1/2 of Red thread 1/4 1/2 put in
 12th Dr. a coil of hay upper side gathering fishes & 5th killed
 13th 3rd the Ram gathering & the day finished on 7th 1/2 1/2
 14th on the east side for the first fishing at night
 15th got 3 eels & a catfish &c Sunday & Fortunate Day
 16th for raising Salt Water Morning lightning & 11th Fortunate
 17th the Barn blowing some on the Kill Point & Behind
 18th the Barn Raining & Blowing hard from the West
 19th Black Birds & Birds Bad Birds Bad Cow Bad
 20th wanting to be in Hazard & out of it
 21st 30th the cherries good good Berries & Blackberries
 22nd on good Butter not good at the house

Aug 1865

Mr James Cameron Island

Tuesday. Moving Back the Barn very sick 9th moving
 a great many Indians going down to the Long Black Beach
 Put in 16 coils on the east side of the Barn & good
 hay 10th Put in on the east side 9 coils of grass &
 clover Dan and Allen came Pete Bosell put
 them across began to rain a Fortunate Day 11th moving
 picking chokes cherries Dan & I put Dan and Allen
 across to Henerys took supper at Henerys Heard how
 Remshaws wood and Wharf was burnt by the
 Steamer H. O. P. S. Sparks brought 2 Books
 to Gordon Dan did 12th The Salabery a Pleasant
 trip to Cornwall gathering and putting in put
 16 coils on the West side and put 10th on the east side
 140 coils on the West side now and 32 on the east
 side 13th a change in the Moon Bob skiddled &
 took the Basket and chairs, sat new come today
 a Boat around that stole Bob away 14th cutting about
 the same Indians coming down now to fish and
 steal a very very warm day to day Blackbirds
 had 15th Livinia Gordon and Mary went to Dunedin
 to see their grandmother John Nine came for a Summer
 and with a saw showed him the land and
 cutting the Peace made 5 coils of Hay above
 the Lane this is an awful warm day
 Lightning to night Blackbirds commenced the
 Corn sent them my spade and Hammer & Basin
 16th got 2 Loaves of Bread from them for Potatoes
 got 4 1/2 lbs of Indian for Potatoes & corn
 stuff to shake Potatoes & corn the Louisiana
 came home 17th cutting Hay cut the Wheat as
 the Hens and Bards finished it all Pat
 came & went across John brought 4 Loaves 1/3 I paid this and
 the Hamble 5 cents 18th night took 3 1/3 went on Board the Naft
 coming back
