June 18 Tuesday forward
 Very warm day thunder & lightning at night a little rain. We finished plowing and nearly finished disking dump field No 7 we hauled 4 big stones off it to-day and two yesterday all of which we dug out and pulled out with chain.

 Exceedingly warm AM sunny. Cloud over thunder lightning and heavy rain in PM. Willie went down town with team in AM got at Wilsons pig feed 1485 paid 985 also flour 1050 at Merris nails 350 at Armstrongs groceries 15 Millsment 70 fish 30 35 hats Russell 30. He went down in buggy in PM got glass for upstairs window & putty 49 ds and at Armstrongs # Grass 1.25 buckwheat (2 bush) 120 groceries 75 sold 4 1/2 doz eggs 16 72. He went up to Swine River to see get sheep shears he lost (unsuccessful). I dug out foundation for kitchen cleared barn etc. Mr Sars over in evening trying his new sprayer.

Butterford and Mother Annie Jennie & Norman Sandham up in PM & for tea. I thinned some mangels bought from Alex McKee being 10cts
