I cut wood rest of day Willie took down to 7 & 8 going for 2nd load 17 doz eggs @ 20cts \$3.40 got groceries \$1.83 balance cash also bananas 10 cts Mary got them, also fruit 1.19 at Woods load 16 oz Russell stamps 12 cts in Phillips also camphor & rubber 10 cts cards 5 cts. Willie went down town at night got at Nichols sand paper 5 cts got Express order for seeds for Downchair Bros 1.35 also for J.A. Summers \$1.05 cost of order 10 cts got hair cut at Graham's 20 cts. The Melne girls Helen & Jean to go home to-day out of quarantine.
