

And Gannan Island 3rd Sept 1874
 being in the Back Marsh Mr. Fulton here and
 down in Law George Renshaw came to a blow in
 Marsh 10th Working at the hay making for 11th at hay
 began the Marsh hay stack 13th Sunday I think
 is the Sunday the fire took in Cornwall fishing
 a lunge and a lot of Pickered and perch 14th I crossed
 Lumsden ^{got 5th dollars + more at Baker} Mr. Spencer and Alfred Henry here
 night got the Rat in the Trap 15th Went down
 Fish with Mr. Spencer Below the Sturgeon Island
 to the Lamp chimney 16th Moved some 17th Cutting
 for the stable Putting the stable down 18th in the Bush
 commenced the stable and 1st sticks to
 20th Went to the Bay to Fish Turned Windy 21st
 the stable 22nd Mr. Spencer here and Boy Barton
 brought me some Fat Pine 23rd Fast Day of Fall
 Sturmen took very very sick as I went out to Fish a
 warm Day 24th at the stable Gordon went to
 pellets to see if they were coming to cut the Marsh 25th
 Gordon and I to the store paid 10 for the 4 loaves
 Bread salt thread Gordon went this evening
 for the Flour 3.50 Paid this John in Toronto 26th at the
 table 27th at Kitt Kat very Windy seen Dunn and
 Briggs 28th in the Bush 29th at the stable St.
 Michaelmas 30th Went to blumitons went up
 the Store John and I came down to the house
 George Renshaw and Wife went to Finch
 1st of October in the Bush 2nd at the stable
 at the Blains in 4th Sunday 5th Foggy
 at the morning 6th or 7th Propellers a Race going
 in 6th and 7th at the stable 8th Put up the last
 and set 4 traps for the first 5th getting a
 in the bush got 2 Rats 10th Hugh and
 11th Day Gordon went to Boxell's for chest
 to the store for Tea combinator
 at Summers down

 10th High Wind went around the Island Found a Quail Jar
 at the West side of the stable roof 13 at the Roof no
 more nails cut some Marsh hay in the swamp
 Back of the Barn 14th Went across with 4³ Bushel
 of Ashes 15 cents a Bushel Bought of Ciponds 44 cut nails
 2³ cents 2³ lb clinch nails 7 cents 3³ qds of Cotton at 10 cents
 Went to Alice Blondiau's he is in Widow I chin
 Summer's house now 15 finished the Roof Forced the
 Gable Ends 16th Laying the Bams for the floor
 and most part of the floor Hung the Door took
 up the Potatoes in the Back garden 17th
 took up the Last of the Potatoes in front of the house
 Made a Whipple Tree set Fires in Brass Blow
 the House Windy a good deal of shooting a turkey
 and took up the Turnips Killed 2 Rusters
 18th St. Luke's Day cold some and Windy Canadian did not
 stop tonight in Lancaster kept across to the St. Linnet
 set some traps no working of Rats in the Back
 Marsh Found a Bottle in the Bushes (See & Rivins)
 the owl took away another of the hens Manitoba went
 to day the water low but Raising some tide
 19th Weather Windy 19th William and the 2 Boys came
 in a Clarks Hay covering the calf shed Got that
 20th William stacking made 2 stacks put 2 cobs
 in the stable chinking the stable Thunder Raining
 fine Windy 21st finishing the stable floor and at the stable
 drew some wood out of the Back Marsh
 chinking the West End of the house 22nd Moving some
 cobs in the stable loft Fixing the Loge barn Drew up the
 Red canoe drew the Fish Bore Tied Alder Bark for Wreast
 at no good 23rd Lucia's Birth Day a fine Day 1868 Plastering
 24th Our Hugh's Birth Day Drew the Ash Stick up in the Barn
 in the Marsh Hay Back West of Barn drew some Wood Peggy and
 etc Basell here for their sugar 24th
