the fore noon. Snow after noon.  
Thu Jan 21<sup>st</sup> dull cloudy day about five inches  
of snow fell last night melted to day  
Fri Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> cloudy soft and wet Sarah  
was here baking and cleaning house.  
Rose called in awhile in the after noon  
Sat Jan 23<sup>rd</sup> cloudy and cool. drizzling snow  
most of the day Dow was here for  
dinner Thomas Bolton was in this  
after noon. Sarah called this evening  
Sun Jan 24<sup>th</sup> cold and blustering the monster  
Sat Zero Sharley sick  
Mon Jan 25<sup>th</sup> clear fore part of the day and  
12 deg colder than yesterday Fred  
was here and Dick part of the  
after noon. I had a job with the  
pump this morning getting it  
thawed out it was froze solid
