 Tannin's shingles for our Silo Bishop  
 gets it from London at \$18.00 per M  
 11 A helped Carpenter all day I grubbed  
 Corn with drill & harrowed potatoes  
 Chopped C.M. he & Florin brought  
 100 quarter thousand shingle bunches from

west of Markham we got them from  
 Bishops they had them delivered there  
 to shingle a building & decided not  
 come to the station so they gave us  
 them to put on Florin's barn W. very  
 fine & warm like thunders going around  
 12 A helped Carpenter all day Henry  
 & I March (Rufus' Man) thinned Mangles  
 A.M. then Henry helped Carpenter P.M.  
 I & I made a drill for Sweet Potatoes  
 & I helped and hilled at Mangles A.M.  
 he topped thistles P.M. he took Mary  
 to Dr. after supper. She had Eczema's  
 on her feet & legs I & Navy took a  
 drive to Geo Davidsons to see when the  
 road machine is coming to grade  
 on Pickney township. They intend to  
 come on Friday. W. very warm & clear  
 13 A & Henry helped Carpenter I went to bring  
 a few more squares shingles & took 6 bunches  
 to exchange the buy brought 2<sup>nd</sup> class in a  
 mistake he grubbed on road where they  
 plowed a few weeks ago then he grubbed  
 the turnip ground & took Butter & Eggs  
 to Lewis A.M. Rebecca Duffie & her  
 boys Benjamin & Levi. were here to supper  
 she is still able to be up & around  
 W. very warm District Theodore tonight  
 I brought little Eva with me Navy & I took  
 her home this evening
