 Mock suns around the sun
 2 Mock suns on the north side and 1 on the south
 Broke on another stack at the
 north door 5th Christmas Day
 Fine Day ice making not
 much wind and not frost but
 a big stain of ice Leander and
 Stanley to sturgeon Island with the
 15 oars of 6" fine 3 of snow
 27th St John the Evangelist Day
 colder Monday oiling Harness
 28th Fine W Wind ice up
 making a skin across
 took home the sheep

James Cameron Island 29th December
 Uncle Argie's Cameron Bay
 & Wind not very cold not cold
 enough to make good ice big
 air-hole Before the door Gordon
 and Leander went to the head
 of the Island to see how it look
 all open up there looks good
 Between here and Plum Island
 lots of air-holes no faces come
 Last night fine day some cakes
 13 breaking off in the air hole Leander
 foot not very well seen a
 large bird of some kind Goose or
 Eagle or owl in the North Bay
 30th Fine W Wind Thawing Rain
 ice that made is all going
 down Seen a Boat crossing
 it to some of Lewis's a Rose
 on here to night 31st Fine Day
 Gordon crossed for the Mail got a
 parcel from Minnie got a cheeze
 from Dan with 10 mlt to 2
 Bottles of R.R.R. Leander got a letter
 from McAlle a piece of her dress
 from Minnie a feather for Pa Blue
 for Pepper Dish for Ma for Sussy
 and some for Tonia Gordon crossed
