

Dec 25th 1892

Sun 25th Xmas day, first anniversary of the commencement of this diary, snowing all day, quite hard, four or five inches fell, clearing up about sunset. Got home & wife here today attended Church with John Warner tonight lovely moonlight night but very cold

Thermometer 25°, but lovely sunshine all day, Melissa and Gusta returned home from Watertown tonight

Tue 27th

Thermometer 9° lovely all day quite warm during the middle of the day, growing colder at night

Thermometer 11° another fine sunny day, beautiful weather for Christmas holidays

Thermometer 10° but still all together lovely most beautiful weather I have ever seen at this season of the year it is ~~as~~ as one would wish at Xmas time, attended an Xmas tree held Wilton, being one of John Warner Gusta Warner Ida Warner Sands Latimer and Sister, John Gage and Miss Prescott, we had a lovely time the night was a beautiful moonlight, but very cold

Fri 30th

A little milder this morning, a light snow falling during the forenoon clearing off at noon clouding over again at night

Sat 31st

Mild and cloudy all day, having the appearance of a storm finally clearing, the last of fires of 1892. One years diary completed
