off to Dougwatts took Home their Pan.
they had at the Frickasee Ploughing
in the upper field Greased the Stove
outside 2nd All Souls Day Fine
Ploughing in the upper field Randolph
here Eddy here got papers from Johnston
Gorant 3rd Unfortunate Day & Wind
Stanley Leander Eddy Renshaw went to
Dundee changed Stockings Mr Sablow
and Mr Armstrong came here to night
East Wind Blowing pretty well some
Shooting 4th & Wind Fine Day Mr Armstrong
Gave one Dollar and 50 cents they
were shooting on the Little Island
South side put up the Single Stove pit
Fire in to see how the pipes and chimney
would act. South East Wind Eddy here
Lots of shooting Gave 50 cents to Sonia
Stanley Ploughing Leander went to Fix the
Blinds John H. went yesterday to Debowers
Brought Plurgeon to D. Spunk D. Spunk here
5th Guy Fawkes Day a Fortunate
Day one of the Big Sea Boats
went Down - continued

Fine George came to Thrash and Sonia
went to this place 2 1/2 of Butter 60
putting up the Mill and fixing around
it Stanley went to Make 2 Stacks
in the Marsh him and Eddy Renshaw
Fernandez Digging Stones at the cord
Wogel Randolph here taken the Mill out
6th Lizzie Anne Cameron Creamer's Day
1899 Fine Day Randolph here Began
the Thrashing about 12 o'clock Thrashed
out 1 Stack about Bushels Shook the
Horses splitting stove Wood Frost tonight
7th Mrs Helen Burton's Birth Day
1842 59 years to Day Fine Day Boys
at the Thrashing The Plurgeon taken away
to night Thrashed 40 or 48 Bushels of Wheat
Began an oat stack stacking Straw
& rained a little kind of misty dull
stacking straw and corn stalks together
trying to finish this stack of oats today
one of the sea vessels went down the
morning killed 1/2 doz of chickens
to Day and a sturgeon yesterday
8th King Edwards Birth Day the
11th year for him to be King Ravn
Windy George went home Captain
Billy Morris and George Losala on
Windy Unfortunate Day 10th Unfortunate
Day Windy Boys went to spear eels got
one Billy went off Gordon here
told us Dan Spunks Boat was stole
By an Indian 11th St. Martin's Day or
Marlinmas Day took over the Brick & Wind
taking stones to the Bank some
Flakes of Snow fell Rained to night
