- 18 Marion 5 yds rappahannock 13. 65 1 lb tea 30

- 19 Very heavy rain about 3 P.M. and slight showers all day. Tossie & wife in for a while last night 1 lb raisins 10

- 26 Pretty fine day, Monday 1st yesterday
- 27 Dr. Mc Leman to see Birdie
- 28 Pa went to Cornwall, drove to Summerville, took the train. Jimmie 5 loaves 25. Smidlers left for Windsor
- 29 Rain. To steak 30. Jimmie has toothache pain
- 30 Rain, but not many in church, Rev. A. Beattie of Perth preached.
- 31 To 1/2 bush dutchess, 25
