45<sup>cts</sup> pr family
- 25 I made a large washing, put out  
but half of it. Hatty came this evening
- 26 Cold today. wind high. I baked in  
oven. Murphy drove Hatty to her school
- 27 Wednesday. Cold East wind until evening  
then it began to snow. Murphy went to  
look for the colts. but did not  
find them
- 28 Storming fearfully. Was up at 5 A.M.  
Murphy drove Birdie to Martintown  
to attend the school promotion. The  
snow was in some places up to  
the horse backs. it gave a good  
renewing to the old cutter.
- 29 Roads better today. No mail from Martintown  
yesterday. Josephine took the mail from  
Lancaster Murphy went for Birdie. Hatty  
came in afternoon. she was in the Glen
- 30 Saturday. There was a meeting to organize  
a Loyal League of Temperance, held  
in the vestry. 32 present
