Very cool last night, some say a slight frost. Willie drove down in morning took cream to Russells also 1.95 lbs potatoes to Ellis @ 4.05
 3 45 per bag \$2.27 got shorts \$1.40 chicken feed \$1.50 2 27 290
 paid balance on grain got May 24th 5-5. Willie plowed J.L. A.M. and I fixed fence around new land No 4 scuffled some in new orchard dug flower bed etc. Fred Bowley over P.M. he and Willie clipped 5 sheep. Fred took sick and went home. I plowed and harrowed at J.L. P.M. near Fords fence. We drove up to see cattle at Allans came home by Gass' and got lend of his shears. 55
