Cloudy A.M. rained a few drops cleared off P.M. warm day. We hauled 10 loads oats from 7.L. field to-day two teams. Mr. Goss over at night with milkery orders 50 ds. milk 5

Wednesday

Fine sunny warm day windy P.M. We brought last loads from 7.L. also six loads from No 2 about 3 of wheat and 3 of oats and barley (we put two strings of oats in bottom wheat on top to put into shed) this finishing No 2. Meet 60 Horton father mother uncle Jim Auntie and Robert Ross up for tea. Nellie & baby Donald came up after tea for some black earth. Willie drove father & uncle Jim down. Robert gave us each a Simon 1 cent piece got out this year in honor of his centenary with initials of the designer on it.

Thursday

Fine sunny day warm got cooler at night We plowed in No 6 suffled some turnips leaved out No 7. 7.L. cemented another step at back door. I buried dead sheep in morning.

Friday

Fine sunny warm day. Willie at Dix' threshing A.M. I plowed at 7.L. with Mand and Dan till broke shear then came back worked at back door steps. P.M. we cut some of No 5 went over to whole field then cut at bottom part Liguora oats, top from the oats badly down. Mr. Goss over at night milk 5. he has bought a horse & buggy. Lou Sargent in at night looking at Dan. He has bought the McAllister farm.
