September 5	continued Monday toward We cut almost all of Braggin oats in S. field when tongue of binder broke. I stoof up. after tea we hauled in load from No 2. Jersey 'Ladysmith' calved this morning twins a bull and heifer the heifer died. Laborday.	104748 106559
6	Tuesday Fine sunny day. Willie whaled down to Memphis in morning got 6 bolts for binder tongue 10cts we mended it and finished cutting oats in S field thus finishing cutting. we hauled in 8 loads Jeanette oats from S field today. Father up in PM helping us.	10
7	Wednesday Fine in AM clouded over in PM thunder lighting and rain about 5 o'clock. We took in rest of Black oats 2 loads and rest of No 2 4 loads finished just before the rain. Willie paid Doug M. Lean in full 40cts Mary down in PM got burns 5cts she brought up and Mary. We went up to see the cattle at night with Scott.	40 5
8	Thursday Cloudy day. Willie harrowed full wheat land twice and I stoofed up rest of S. field We got chop 9 lbs 45¢ at Currier took down 645 lbs oats @ 33 bushel and 132 lbs wheat to Armstrong on aft and got map basket plums 15 ¹⁵ ¢ tomatoes ³⁵ ¢ and paid for following Graham flour 10¢ oatmeal 10¢ soap 5¢ vinegar 10¢ meat at hills 25 pullets and corns 10¢ Gouard special starch 10¢ Uncle Willie took aunt May home to day.
