 per M. Cubic Measure W. rather cloudy
 14 I & John brought Colt. Farmer from pasture
 then went rabbit shooting with B. Finlans Daniel &
 Peter Hones little John shot 1 Aaron plowed
 15 I & Aaron plowed W. very fine clear
 16 Both finished plowing below orchard then cleared
 some Peas Michael Frates came on a visit Aaron
 dug out pine root below Orchard I. took goat
 Chop to mill this evening. W. fine roads good
 17 I went to H. Stouers & to Cherrywood A.M. went
 shooting to J. D. with J. B. awhile P.M. W. fine
 18 Pulled down fence east of lane as far as ~~Cherry~~
 Creek on Scobors townline & built it up again
 we intend to dig post holes for a board fence
 built up fence across creek above dam &
 behind Orchard. W. east wind. Cloudy
 Sunday 19 at home. nobody here W. drizzling
 20 I went to Markham & to Unionville to Register
 Daughter Mary Aaron Mearns Peas W. rain
 21 I went to Cherrywood ^{Simon Hones's were here this morning} cloudy
 Orchard P.M. W. mild cloudy
 22 Finished drawing dung A.M. cleared drift out of
 fence at townline & depend Creek & put in some
 posts Mainland is digging holes. W. pretty sharp
 23 I helped B. C. kill hogs W. chilly cloudy
 24 Put in some posts Aaron chopped I went
 to A. B.'s to Cherrywood P.M. W. cool
 25 I went to J. Dick's for 2 pigs @ \$1.25 each
 Then I went to bush to see Timbers measured 2083 ft
 W. soft snow. Aaron helped make fence at meeting home yard P.M.

Sunday 26 at home ^{Nov} 1876 ^{Dec} were here this evening
 W. some soft snow a few slight minning today
 27 killed our 6 hogs W. mild a little soft snow
 28 I helped C. B.'s folk kill hogs W. mild some
 soft snow. Throwing ^{meat} slightly of wheeling
 29 I helped B.'s folk kill hogs Aaron chopped. W. clear
 30 I & Adeline helped A. B.'s kill hogs. W. very cold
 Dec 1 we Chopped & drew sawed wood into shed
 2 drew wood into shed boys took ¹⁵ bus chop
 to mill W. cold. a little sleighing ^{at home & Caroline's place here tonight}
 Sunday 3 I & Children went to meeting at Hebron
 Nancy staid at home. remarks by B. C. sermon
 on Luke 5: 18 to end of Chap. by Rev. Hones
 4 I went to J. D. & to Mahassett's to my
 I Lehman's were here Christian Stouers came P.M.
 they brought B. Lehman & wife from Stant
 Township. W. pretty sharp
 5 I & Nancy took B. Lehman & wife to B. C.
 to J. D. at noon then to B. N. to stay all
 night then I went to mill for Chop. W. mild
 6 I & Aaron helped B. C. I truck with team W. fine
 7 Went to Finlans. W. very fine roads splended
 8 I & Aaron sawed wood in old bush A.M. ^{there I &}
 Nancy went to Cedar Grove P.M. W. pretty cold
 9 Cleared Peas & Choral. W. very cold. very
 strong north wind all day
 This is my Nancy's 3rd Birth day
 Sunday 10. Went to B. C. W. very cold B. D. by ^{youngster}
 11 I & Aaron to Chop to Cedar Grove this morning I took
 Frank & Nell to get shed P.M. W. 5 in snow last
 night & A.M. mudding slightly. mild
 12 I took 38 bus 5-3 lbs Old Treadwell wheat to Cedar
 Grove Mills @ \$1.15. A.M. drew last of wood
 into shed P.M. W. few in snow last night. fair
 13 I & Nancy took Aaron home. then went to Daniel
 Hones. went shooting got nothing W. mild. sleighing
 going. Took 12 bus goat this morning got it home
 tonight
