TORONTO, Feb. 11.—(Special)—The weather bureau reports the cold wave of yesterday unchanged in position and increased in severity, with no prospects of a milder temperature. The forecast is the same for Ontario, Quebec and the Maritime Provinces to-day, and to-morrow, "fair and continued extremely cold." Every province from Alberta east reports zero weather or lower. White River, as usual, taking the "cake" with 54 at eight o'clock this morning. Winnipeg reports 38 below, Saulte Ste Marie, 22; Toronto, 12; Kingston, 30; Ottawa, 26; Montreal, 26; Quebec, 32; St. John 16, and Halifax four. Other places in Quebec report 36 below zero.
