- 2 fine day warm & thawing Ad & his load got home I bored part of rock for the sheep
- 3 I fixed the rings & put the part I had bored together the snow nearly at gone Belle & Jennet got home they were at Ferrisville & young
- 4 Rev. Mr. Robinson preached this morning Mr. Duntlop at 3 o'clock Mr. Mathews at 6 o'clock
- 5 went to town meeting voted for Mr. Duntlop <sup>sum of \$100</sup> Webster, Peck & Richardson councillors Belle put <sup>in double Sash below</sup>
- 6 rain & snow most of the day
- 7 heavy rain most of the night & this morning
- 8 the snow is nearly gone the roads is very poor
- 9 closed the annual meeting of the Sons of Iowa & Agriculture Societies in Westons hall resigned the President ship of the Societies John Cook was elected president I was put in one of the directors
- 10 we went to Delta as a delegate to the Conservative Convention D. F. Jones was chosen as member for the nomination to be held on the 22 inst at Ferrisville there was a good meeting and with what I was in bed most of the day I burn my pants for some time fine day
- 11 the Rev. Mr. Cochran preached this morning & the Rev. Mr. Mathews in the evening I was not able to go
- 12 I am not able to do any thing yet Ad cut wood & attended to the fixing for a dea meeting in the church there was a very large meeting Rev. Messrs Gordon, Cottone & Cochran the proceeds about \$60
- 13 Ad & the girls cleared out the church fine day
- 14 Ad took me to the schoolhouse in the valley to attend the annual Schol meeting Thomas Gilbert was held <sup>a fine variety of goods</sup> <sup>this morning</sup> I went to Jonanogue with St. Spang in the Stage <sup>for an air jacket</sup> but cold fine day but cold
