Orchard planted 2 rows Dand Warrior in rows nearest 2 in row trees from S E fence also nearly 4 rows linnel beyond the ones I planted before Mary planted out cabbage & she got at home this morning she having walked down to see if F was going to Sulph. I also fixed some at fence N. W. of barn. Belle got ^{over} ^{etc} ^{etc} ^{etc} out for Mady.

Thursday

Considerable rain last night raining some in morning gradually cleared off fine by late PM. Willie and I drove down in morning to see if F & M were going to Sulph. I drove them up here as they decided not to go to Sulph to-day and Willie got his tooth fixed at Bottom. We harrowed the corn also all plowed land in No 6 and plowed some more. I fixed fence N W of barn also chopped 3 kinds PM. Willie and Mary drove down to Welsh choir concert in 7th at night took F & M down with them. Willie got a Mat
