

Mr Mills (William) Island 15<sup>th</sup> Oct 1852  
 Rained some Windy Fine Made 2 Whippletrees  
 Stanley Making a Waggon with Wheels Stanley  
 Plastering the Hen-house the Bohemian near  
 going Down the same Day the 2 Hunters  
 up to night from the Shanty Bushy hees  
 a Shoemaker and the other a Machinest  
 works for the water corporation  
 20<sup>th</sup> an Eclipse to Day and the New Moon  
 comes in a very fine Day pulling up old Wood  
 on the Bush Leander to Plum Island those  
 2 Hunters went off to Day from the Shanty  
 Mr Hume's here for Milk 21<sup>st</sup> Fine Windy  
 Leander to Summerstown Bought of Mr Ward 35  
 Soda & Powder 250 Caps 10 Stanley and I to the  
 Sturgeon Island cutting Brush and Hay  
 putting out manure Drove 2 Beams for the  
 cow stable a good many Ducks Flying  
 past to Day Heard Dan Fraser's Daughter  
 was married this Week 22<sup>nd</sup> Fine Leander  
 to Charles Island for Ducks Mr Hume's is  
 going off I suppose for Election taking the  
 of top of the stable cut some Brush the  
 Fishermen got a Lamp from us 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 Lavinia's Bath Day 1868 Fine Windy Mr Hume  
 John Fernandez and J McDonald there  
 24<sup>th</sup> Our Hugh's Birth Day giving  
 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Logs on the cow stable Fine Windy  
 Mr Hume Made 2 Oxchandelles for one Leander  
 shot 3 Ducks Alexandra went Down

Mr Mills (William) Island 25<sup>th</sup> Oct 1852  
 my Birth Day 1825 67 years old to day  
 Cool Fine Windy Mr Hume got a Sow up  
 Cornwall wrote 2 Directions one to Thomy  
 Broswa Beauharnois advocate the other  
 for Montreal & using poles on the cow  
 fixed the Butter tub a small one only 12 lbs  
 of Butter St Crippin's Day Mr Hume  
 came from Cornwall had some Brecks Bought  
 the 4 Glass for us and and 3 lb of nails 72 and  
 Brought Back 8 cents which is 80 cents had a Great  
 26<sup>th</sup> Fine Rained some to night sent the small  
 Tub of Butter Down with Narcisse Shora to D. Mc  
 Mr Hume Made 2 Whippletrees Leander shot 2 Duck  
 Killed a Mutton Pretty Good one Calm to Day  
 Dick Leander Mr Hume went to Fish to night  
 Martin Lewis Boy here for an auger gave him  
 the 2 inch auger got 6 Sturgeon 10 suckers  
 2 2 Elms 1 Pickrel 1 perch 2 y<sup>th</sup> at the Banking  
 Windy Cool Fine some Drops of Rain salted the  
 Mutton salted 2 Sturgeon Martin came  
 with the auger they killed their cow 28<sup>th</sup>  
 Fine some Rain Lewis here for Milk Mr Hume  
 went off Leander went to Summerstown Bought  
 of Mr Ward a sack of salt pipes 2 Plastering  
 calves shed 29<sup>th</sup> Raining Killed the Turkey  
 oil to the Fishermen set Traps in the cellar  
 30<sup>th</sup> Windy the 2 herts went to crags at the Point  
 31<sup>st</sup> Fine of hollowen or Holy Eve Drove some  
 Drags of wood sawed a maple that was burned out  
 of the Roots cracking nuts Dick here Leander shot  
 a Loon and 4 Ducks
