 tried to sell Jess in Guelph. Mr. Hoffmann was  
 looking at her on way home. Bill Mutch  
 finished moving down to Saraprawe Mt and the  
 McKenzies finished moving up to his place now the  
 property of Mrs Mackie who also lives with McKenzies.

 we spread 5 loads manure on No 7. Willie

 for Jess 25cts. Willie got salt 25 sugar 25 at Brunstrom  
 then went to station for Guelph stuff (see 4th) paid

 meeting at school we appointed D. McHardy chairman  
 and Byers Sec. I ran. I drove down at  
 night Mary and I went to prayer meeting in our
