 25 I was cleaning up seed Grain all Day a little Showy
 26 I was plowing sod on the Keating Place to Day a very warm Day
 another terrible Hat Day 60 in the Shade (all Day)
 27 I finished plowing sod on the Keating Place to Day
 I got a new watch chain & a new watch (maid of South) Day
 28 I was breaking in the sod to Day it works a nice cool
 a very Hat Day I had Joshua Humphrey sowing with drill
 29 I sowed 7 Bushels of peas on the Keating Place to Day
 North ends very long an Hat The 500 F marched to Schurch to Day a 2300
 another very Hat Day 80 in the Shade to the M.C. Church

- Month - May, 31. Day 8 1899

a very heavy thunder storm in the afternoon
 I commenced to sow our wheat to Day 1 1/2 Bushels sowed
 2 I was letting off water to Day the ground is very wet
 a very cool Day I finished 1 1/2 on the Keating Place 6 Bushels
 3 I finished sowing wheat to Day Mr Haslip commenced to work
 a nice cool Day Mr Haslip was helping me all Day 8 150
 4 I was sowing oats on the Keating Place to Day 8 Bushels sowed
 a very Hat Day The ground works very hard on the Keating Place 3 hours this evening
 5 I was breaking in an sowing all Day Mr Haslip was helping me
 a nice cool Day I have 26 Bushels of grain sowed on Keating Place Mr Haslip was helping me
 6 I was working on the Keating Place all Day with 2 Teams 7-15 PM
 a very nice warm Day Miss Lizzie Mollen died at
 Mr Haslip was helping me all Day with team Place
 8 another very warm Day I was working up on the Keating
 Mr Haslip helped me to Day a very nice warm Day
 9 Mark and I went to Lizzie Mollens funeral with the Ladies
 Day to Day
 10 I finished up sowing on this side of the Road on the Keating Place
 Mr Haslip was helping me all Day 75
 11 I rolled sun the fore noon a very heavy rain
 Mr Haslip was helping me 1/2 2 Day 75
 12 I was sowing grain on the Keating Place all Day
 Mr Haslip helped me all Day 150
 13 We finished sowing on the Keating Place to Day 52 Bushels
 a very cold Day The wind is North West a hard frost
 14 We went to Ed Mollens funeral in the afternoon a very cold Day
 I was breaking in ground to Day I had Mr Haslip helping me
 a very heavy frost a little rain to Day warmer
 15 I sowed the Barley to Day 6 Bushels I had Mr Haslip helping me
