 cutting Brush in oakfield 5th soft slushy no
 snow in the fields Brushing 10th cutting
 Brush 11th Fine & Wind no snow on the ground
 Ice crackling seen 2 Men fishing 2nd on
 the North side above the Squaw Island
 Gordon here 12th No. 10 in brush
 a vessel seen the Fox Croft
 soft Rained very hard W Wind turned fine
 cutting Brush on the Lower Point 13th cutting
 in the oakfield Fine & freezing ground hard
 ice crackling 14th W Wind Began to snow
 cutting Brush in oakfield drifting Randolph
 making a chair slipper for the cattle
 watering them at the Wet Place east of the
 House & freezing to night not much snow
 in the oakfield clearing Leander and I
 some snow 15th E Wind to night drifting blowing hard holed through
 the night New Moon 16th Windy changed to
 drifting blew hard all day did not water the
 the Blew hard all from the West Leander
 and I in the oakfield Randolph
 some wood 17th Stormy West Wind drifting
 did not water the cattle to day as
 they would not drink 18th Fine to day
 but cold 19th cold drifting W Wind stands still
 with cold Leander and I in the oakfield
 20th Randolph John H. Livinia all sick
 Windy drifting seen a Rabbits track

 about 15 bundles of hay all got the cold 22nd
 very frosty frosty cold day windy all of us
 had with the cold 23rd fine calm for a while
 blowing some Green some loads of Alders put

 Livinia making a pair of Pants for Randolph
 24th Charles Suppers Birth Day & Wind snowing
 drifting some cold kind of soft this evening
 not very well 25th kind of fine 26th cold snowing
 drifting took the 2 Sugar pots from under a
 blanket of snow 27th frosty blowing drifting
 28th E Wind blowing drifting W Wind 29th frosty
 West Wind drifting cold Bad with my feet
 cannot stand the cold 30th kind of soft Randolph
 went to Sumnerston Bought 2 Packages
 the Prize Tea Water got Butter Dish glass and 2
 Cups and Saucers Thread 5 Darning needles 1 Cent
 Suzzies in Montreal got the Mail 4 papers
 1st Randolph went to Fort Barrington Fine
 frosty sold his Munk 50 cents Bought oil 11
 matches 10 Hair pens 5 Essence of Peppermint 15 got
 my watch 7 m. 25 so Dicket cutting ice for
 the ice house John H. and I Draving wood
 27 of Feb. Mary Laundry snowing drifting
 East and North W Wind 2nd (Candlemas Day)
 seen 2 Foxes Cropping from Christies to here the
 Sun shines to Day the Bear if he comes
 out he will see his shadow or the Raccoon
 on the sticks above the floor 3rd Mrs James M. D. original
 here came to see if one of the Boys would go
 and stop for a while gave the Baby 5 cents told
 me he paid 15 cents for the globe cold
 frosty fine commenced the north side
 of the east snow I. J. D. all told me a lot
