

April 19th 1892.

Tue. 19. Very Beautiful day, warmer than usual. Wind mostly west this evening is just lovely. I am feeling tired again tonight

Wed. 20. Beautiful day, still warmer than yesterday. Wind east during the forenoon, changing ^{East} ~~South~~

Thu. 21. Fine clear morning, clouding over and commencing to rain about noon, continuing all the afternoon. Made my first Cheese today I. only. The wind was S. East all so far.

Fri. 22. Mild after rain of yesterday partly cloudy, very high South East winds. a few light showers at night. received letter from J. P. W.

Sat. 23. Dull and cloudy this morning clearing off, and turning fine wind west. Then wind N West

Apr 23rd 1892.

Sat. 23. At about six o'clock and turning extremely cold. Northern lights to night. / freezing /

Sund. 24. Clear and bright. but very cold. Wind north, changing to all points and north at night freezing hard. Northern lights

I went to Church in the morning. Sunday School in the afternoon. Then James Lane and myself had our tea at his Sister's Mrs. Barnes, after tea we attended prayer meeting, and returned home, so ended the day

Mon. 25. Bright and clear, very cold having froze very hard the night previous wind mostly north west, very cold to night

Tue. 26. Lovely clear day, cold this morning turning fine. Wind north west,
