 field is part time for some been worked together  
 since they had it & water 10000 bushels of wheat

 of which labour he had to work here part
- 25 went to the school to see his work & children  
 great deal is done since he has been here  
 in the afternoon very warm day he has been  
 26 had the Samaras & the pop corn in the morning  
 went to a raising of the spine of Methodist church  
 in the afternoon warm day
- 27 went to the school examination in the forenoon  
 & to the raising of the spine of the Methodist church

 afternoon with him expect Bessie to come home
