Gave to Thompson M: Hardy re Glen present 35cts. sold eggs to W Match 8cts

March 1      Thursday

Some snow last night and through day. frosty, cloudy. I spread the load manure Willie brought up from Stebs Sunday on No 6 then went down for chop at Wilsons \$8cts. Willie made a wooden boat to clean out stables with and in PM we cleaned out cattle stable to yard on it with Lucy. Mother up in PM Mary drove her down took Willes butter to Williams @ 19cts lb 75cts also 8lbs to Russells \$1.44 Harry
