- Mon Oct 22. Fine bright day, we swept upstairs.
- Tue Oct 23. Rained gently most of the day, Mrs Teasdale and Clara here to spend the day, Mary Chapman called.
- Wed Oct 24. ~~Further~~ dull and showery, Aunt Mattie went to Toronto, to Aunt Lizzies, Aunt Nellie came home in afternoon. I called at Mary Watsons in the evening, rained all night.
- Thurs Oct 25. Rained and a little snow at first, cleared at noon & bright. Mrs Edwin Sangstaff called. Aunt Nellie at ~~Welliners~~ Sorraime in.
- Fri Oct 26. Fine day, east wind, we put in kitchen window. We sold last three hens 17 cts a lb. the other three at 20 cts. We went to Mrs Littles for pullets five at \$1. a piece, got a bag potatoes \$1.50. Annie here in eve.
- Sat Oct 27. Fine and bright at first, then started rain towards evening & poured all night. I was in Toronto dinner at Aunt Lizzies.
- Sun Oct 28. Cleared and quite bright but windy, I walked to Concord church and dinner at Wellis ^{then home}. we went to evening church.
- Mon Oct 29. Rained heavily all day, we washed. poured and thunder about five o'clock.
