Mostly sunny, cold, frosty, windy. I drove down

 12 ct I paid J.C.D. for News Record for 1917 \$1.00 1 12
 Saw Hugh Black about church account etc. brought
 May up with me. Willie fixed harness.
 405 cut horse trails etc Willie drove May down
 P.M. Lucy in cutter. I went up to Amstrongs at night.

Cold stormy day some sunshine, mostly cloudy
 We did inside work to-day. I finished ^{almost} kitchen
 partition using fibre board Willie fixed harness.
 Mems Collins and Rennie in P.M. starting on their fiftieth
 rounds again. Snowing to-day roads heavy.
