

Camden Gore November 1883

Wed Nov 14th cloudy high wind and cold. the thermometer 24 deg above Zero. I was putting bark bottoms in some chairs

Thu Nov 15th cloudy high wind some snow and quite cold the thermometer lower than yesterday. not doing much to day. killed a small beast for beef. the river froze over last night the first this season

Fri Nov 16th cloudy windy and cold. John and I was husking corn

Sat Nov 17th clear most part of the day and pleasant we were husking corn to day.

Sun Nov 18th clear part of the day and pleasant.

Mon Nov 19th clear and fine. we were husking corn again to day.

Tue Nov 20th cloudy and wet most of the day. I was binding up corn stalks this fore noon after noon. after noon went to Albert Ketcheson's Sale. John was plowing

Wed Nov 21st cloudy and thunder and lightning this morning heavy rain again this evening. was putting up some barley and we mixed to get chapt this fore noon after noon husked some corn John was plowing part of the day.

Thu Nov 22nd cloudy and soft. Walter and I was husking corn John was plowing

Fri Nov 23rd cloudy and cool. finished husking corn. John was plowing

Sat Nov 24th clear part of the day and moderate. John was plowing we drew in the last of the corn this evening

Sun Nov 25th clear part of the day and pleasant

Mon Nov 26th cloudy fore part of the day and wet very heavy rain last night. not doing much

Tue Nov 27th clear and pleasant. was butchering some pigs this fore noon after noon binding up corn stalks

Wed Nov 28th clear and pleasant. this fore noon cutting up and salting the pigs we killed yesterday after noon finished binding the corn stalks

Thu Nov 29th cloudy and soft. I was ditching to day. John and Victoria went to Florence with a load of grain to get chapt

Fri Nov 30th cloudy and cool. a little snow I was ditching. John was plowing in the fore noon after noon took Anne to Dresden She is going to Chatham to see the Doctor. the roads is very bad
