- Feb 17 Rev. Mr. Nicholson preached this morning, 18th Braconat night
18 Ad went to the Shandy with Geordy they intend to stay
all the week they put up a stable last night
19 I took care of the cattle I got cold again the cough
had again fine day I quilled for horses
20 a little grain of snow the buggys running
21 a very little more snow Ad brought two loads
of manure here today that is the first that he
has drawn this week he was backing out
22 heavy rain most of the night & day grain
is very slippery it is dangerous to walk
23 Joseph Caplan was buried at the Union Church
by the Organ men there was about 100 of them walked
in procession from his father's to the church. Ad took
the corps there was 72 buggys & 2 horse men followed
Revd Messrs Nicholson & Bracon officiated
the Roads all in a flap no frost damp & chillia
24 Rev. Mr. Bracon preached this morning Mr. Nicholson at
night 25 Geordy took his ^{market} plow to young to
see Aunt Trabella she is very poorly on
Saturday after Ad came from the funeral very
little frost last night he come home from
young this afternoon Billie come from Detat & went
home again
26 fine day I took care of the cattle Ad chained
the the allowance of road between the 1st & 2nd pair of lanes
down from St. Michaels to B. McCulloughs
27 fine day Geordy went to the 6th concession
some things they wanted permit
28 Ad & Geordy went to a Bee to draw
stones for a new Church of England on
A Cornetts place there was 35 teams
they got a good job done the roads
all in a flap it was a warm day the
stones was got on the farms every place
they had to draw them round the road
