Fine sunny AM clouded over rained a heavy shower PM. Dr Anderson up in morning castrated colt Dick we paid him \$2.00 We cultivated rolled and drilled most of the land between mangels and corn we also sowed fertilizer on it truckage next potatoes phosphoric acid rest. Wilkie drove down after dinner gave father ride up to Grogans etc he harrowed buckwheat after and before rain Mary came up for us to go down, at night as she thought father was worse we all went down Wilkie and I came up again.

Fine AM clouded over rained exceedingly heavy PM. Wilkie and I drove down home got breakfast and brought Bella up. We spread 6 loads manure No 1 AM 2 PM before the rain. We cleared cellar worked at movable pig pen etc. Wilkie Bella and I drove down to see father at night again left Bella down. Kate had a filly foal when we got up.

Cloudy rained a little in evening Wilkie took cream down in morning got liquorie Phillips 17cts stamp 2cts I went to Wm Bonds raising of barn to put stone foundation under Wilkie cultivated and harrowed drills I made on 14th. We went down home at night again
