Very windy but sunny and warmer. Willie went to Station got potatoes from St George. paid 35 cts freight and brought up load manure from pro Quinn which are put on No 1 then brought over load hay from other barn. Willie finished No 6 in P.M. N.C. oats seeded down thus finishing seeding he also harrowed some in No 1 for green crop. I planted the Antishokes to-day West of pighouse. Willie over at Sam McKees in evening.

Tuesday

Very warm day sunny passing clouds. Willie at McKees all day with Kate & Jack helping him with his seeding in return for Sam helping us with road machine in open ditch last fall. I plowed in No 1 W with Jess & Lucy. Mother up in P.M. brought up black raspberry bushes from Smith Winona Experimental farms very Experiment. We planted them in garden as follows from Columbus got from Jess running to SR 4 2 egg then straight across to other row near town and running North again 2 egg to Kansas & Palmer & older. Received for butter 40 paid another 50 cts also 30 for eggs Gave Mr Munster order for back
