

Mr James Cameron Island July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1876  
Went with Lashy to his house got a Big Storage  
a Raft went down in Tow Machine 3<sup>rd</sup> Very  
Windy from the West 2 Boats came in the Evening  
stopt in the Barn stole Lashy's night line pole  
and anchor when they went off they were from  
about Burke a man set 4<sup>th</sup> American 4<sup>th</sup>  
July Centennial Lashy pointed to Laneader having the  
Potatoes 5<sup>th</sup> Our Jones Birth Day 73 years old  
to Day went to 3 Panshaes left Jordan at 1 Hamilton  
got a Bag of Potatoes from John Mr Fulton and Mr  
Ed Plunado came and Mules left me to illunshooks  
Very Windy to night Wind changing to all quarters  
Planned some seen the Potato Bug to Day for the  
first time I seen them on 1 Hamilton Potato  
Young out Jobs on the Roads Peggy Bosell  
and Pete and Leay 6<sup>th</sup> Put out Tobacco Plants  
Mr Fulton went off Paid me for the bars  
stick that miles for 1.25 cents I promised to  
send them to Summerstown and put the  
board of the Steamer Jenny Lashy came  
had the Plants James Y Camerons Daughter  
Departed to Day 7<sup>th</sup> Went to Fort Covington Lashy  
with me Found his line and pole and anchor stopt  
at Lukes took my wool only 20 cents all took it home  
Bought of W Baker Butter July 35 1/4 of Powder 10 Bought  
of Burds Matetes Lashy Paid me 20 cents I paid Lashy  
the discount on Creppens Money Bought of Lilles  
50 lb of Flour 1.62 1/2 to 17 lbs of Bran 17 cents went  
to see Mr Creppen Mr Tuthill sent a Present  
to Livina and gave me a Present of Tobacco  
stopt at Lukes took supper came home John Gray  
and his Brothers here Henry and George Bosell  
for hay the Algornal came out of Santa  
see John Hopkins 8<sup>th</sup> John Gray took Jordan from  
Hamilton put Boards on top of the Cook house put the  
hole to soften in the Water lightning to night  
windy

Mr James Cameron Island July 9<sup>th</sup>  
Looking for the sheep found only 2 of them a  
Fine Day East Wind looks like Rain but no rain  
Thunder an Indian caught a Lunge up in the  
Bay 10<sup>th</sup> crossed to put the bars on Board the Steamer  
Lenny 11<sup>th</sup> Went to Ross Island Fred McDonald  
and Hopkins here 12<sup>th</sup> of July Orangemans Day  
Keeping the 12<sup>th</sup> of July Firing heavy Colley London  
shooting Mr Ross from Cornwall here got some  
worms treated me 13<sup>th</sup> Mowed a Road to the  
Barn 14<sup>th</sup> Mowing some 15<sup>th</sup> London crossed made  
some Cocks of Hay Bought of Cupends 11 Bread  
8 Loaves St Mortens Deer No Rain 16<sup>th</sup> Lashy  
came 17<sup>th</sup> Mowing the Grove 18<sup>th</sup> Mowing  
19<sup>th</sup> Fernandez Birth Day went to Hopkins for the  
White Bull got a Piece of Pork from Limes  
Wife Fred McDonald and Charlie came down  
with me 20<sup>th</sup> high Wind Mowing 21<sup>st</sup> Put in  
20 Cocks from Back of the Barn 22<sup>nd</sup> Went to  
Cupends Bought Bread Tobacco 7<sup>th</sup> a Pie me  
23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> Henry Lene here with a stick  
of Oak stopt all night 25<sup>th</sup> Henry went off 26<sup>th</sup>  
Henry sent the Mare up on the St Francis  
I crossed got the cow <sup>Mr M</sup> Bought of Fred 4 Loaves  
27<sup>th</sup> Taking in Hay 28<sup>th</sup> high Wind cutting and  
yaking in 29<sup>th</sup> Went home with the cow  
John Hamilton Rowed up from the light house  
Bought 8 Loaves Bread with my Back 30<sup>th</sup> Bad  
with my Back got some Spirits of Turpentine  
from Hamilton for my Back 31<sup>st</sup> Drew some  
Wood 1<sup>st</sup> August Annmas Day Henry Lene  
and Boy this Morning stopt till night Mowed  
all Day split some pine 2<sup>nd</sup> Minnies Birth Day  
Gordon crossed got 8 Loaves 3<sup>rd</sup> Mowing 4<sup>th</sup> Mowing  
and Ruttling in Fushing some very warm 5<sup>th</sup> Went  
to Summerstown 7 Loaves 1/2 of 13 1/2  
6<sup>th</sup> Randolphs Birth Day
