28 Cleaned about 120 bus barley
Yorranie took away 50 bus this
morning & Jacale Pearson 40 Bus
tapped trees, over 100 sap run very
fast H went to John Wilroy's P.M.
they had few hands sawing wood
went with F to P Hoover's sale P.M.
F bought spring board @ \$5.75
W. very fine & clear. we gathered big
tub very near full of sap this evening
& most of trees were tapped after dinner
Easter Sunday 29 F & Mary were
here at dinner I & Mary & little
ones went to A B's staid to
supper heard that old Samuel
Stover's son Jimmie died to
day of inflammation on the lungs
