Wednesday

Stormy snowing dense snow flurries at times a little sunshine thenish. We finished rigging up Diamond wagon put box on and went to station for ensilage blower roads bad, we had to move a lot of heavy timber to get away from car. got dinner after 2 P.M. Mary came up this a.m. P.M. we unloaded blower thru out nest of wood that was on bare floor and put it in wagon. Harold Frostham over after school for witness stayed till six. We paid freight on blower \$2.34.

Blowing and snowing a.m. windy all day sunny and cloudy throwing in sunshine. Willie took 8 pigs down sold to Cameron 1320 lbs at 15.40 per cut 203.25 weighing 14 cts P.M. he took the load of cut wood down home in wagon he took the pigs down in sleigh, enough snow having fallen last night to make fresh sleighing again. We trail up 4 of the loose cattle to-day. Willie took 6 doz eggs to Russell @ 30 cts \$1.80 on ~~of~~ balance on March 21<sup>st</sup> transaction 48 cts ~~egg~~ on ~~of~~ eggs 605 goods 57.
