Oct 1st the 1st Drawing Wood to
the Bank sat Black Raspberries in the Bush
Red Raspberries 2nd Drawing Wood Lashey seen
Houghlin on the front the Calves sucking
the Cows 3rd Done Drawing the Wood 4th Done
16th of maple Remained Douch Birch 3rd Done
Birch took up all the Potatoes in the Garden
Great going of Tow Boats very fine weather
Lashey went to Salmon River David Summers
came home & from Co before a sometime
this week 4th Shot 2 Ducks Wind
very high Raining 5th Sunday Went around
the Island Lashey came 6th An Indian
got Potatoes for a small Basket Went
to a Summers seen Day I did
not know he came home till I seen
him coming in the store Bought of
a Summers Whisky 2/10 Powder 1/4
1/4th Tea 2/6 Tobacco 1/3 Braces 1/6 Saleratus 4
Knife 1/2 Herrings 2/6
Hopt at Thomas Summers all night
heard Kenneth Mc Laughlin was to be
married to Day came home took in
all the apples 2 Indians here for
Tobacco

John Summers Stand Oct the 8th
in the Bush James Hopkins & Peter
Grant here wind high Finished
the Raising of the Potatoes Logout
Cut some Marsh Hay in the Back
Marsh 9th Fixing the Red Canoe put in
on the inside 2 of Hamiltons here with
with the 2 Ben houses sold the Wood
to them 4 1/2 cords Maple 8/6 Birch
6/3 2 1/2 Beech and 16 1/2 of Maple
10th Houghlins Birth Day
High East Wind Charles shall one of the lot
Pilots here from a raft going to Ben
apples slept all night gave me 10th for
his supper and Bed 11th Christie wrote here with
2 Baskets gave them Milk & Potatoes went
to the other side to see the Hunters that
used up his stack of Hay, Drawing wood
from the Bush the Pilot here to Dinner
Sunday 12th Rob & Ann here Went to Charles
got some summer savoury gave Bob 3
Daws 2 for the scythe the other for nothing
settled all for the scythe 13th Went to William
Charles & I 4 Bushels of Pease 1 Bag of Potatoes
1 Bag of Apples nuts grapes cranberries stone par
one handle 1 Firkin of Butter Western Bonnet
14th came home Bought of Houghlin
2 1/2 of Shirting at 8th 4/12 1 pool of thread 7
Took Breakfast on Allen Boys Point gave Charles & Lines
some hooks Set my traps for the first setting 7
of them in the Marsh before the door the Hawks
blaying the devil with the Hens
