I scuffled turps with Jess, Willie went down with team got at Armstrong on aft 30 lbs middlings at \$1.20 per and 180 lbs B dust at Watsons make them brought up load wood from brush.

Tuesday

Very warm day sunny and cloudy. rained some after dinner enough to stop all hauling in till after ten. Jim Clark got load of Dick to-day to put on grader and we got his horse jack. Willie scuffled with jack and I with Lucy in turps till about noon then we took in load oats. In P.M. took in 1 and 3/4 load stopped by rain took another load in after ten. Fred Armstrong here in A.M. looking at sick sheep wool all coming off it. got heart in udder though summer blood poisoning effected it we shut it in stable to treat it. Willie went down at night got at Phillips Carbolic acid 15cts and 1 can 5- Shaving soap 5.
