the Rev. Mr. Robinson preached this morning
and at night in their own church

27 had frost last night Ad did not come out I fed
things about the hay pen fine day but cold

Wallace & Bruce helped a little about 4 o'clock

Boys to load the macker they took it

30 very hard frost last night with north
