James Cameron Island 30th of Aug 1854
Fine & Wind Mr Gene went off got
a Bottle of Milk Tona and I
Finished the pulling off of the corn
Seander and Stanley Made a stack
of marsh hay up at the Brush
made 5 coils at the calf-pasture
cut some corn stalks cut my hand
with a knife 31st Fine Made the
Fences at the Hill and at the Stack
at the Barn Seander went to
Jo Douquets for to hunt
1st of September St Giles Day
Hunting Begins in Lower Canada
Gene Gordon went to Pic Nic on
the Rocket to Valley-Field sawed
the floor at the storehouse not
much shooting done husking the
corn gave my arm an awful
blow on the latch of the door
with a load of wood on my arm
2nd Fine & Wind Sews 2 Boys here for
Butter and Milk Mr Gene called
at the wharf going to Cornwall
Gordon came 3rd Mrs M. O. Asters
Birth Day 1846 Fine & Wind
yalling Rails of the calf-pasture
Stanley and I Dred the sticks at
the shanty smoky weather

James Cameron Island 4th of Sept 1854
Fine Wind changed very smoky
Gene now sawing wood made
Picquets Seander came from Dougie
Taking in onions and Beans
5th John Angles Birth Day
1850 Fine Windy some Drops
of Rain Thunder Mowing in the
front Marsh Seander Stanley
and Fernandez Gordon came
had the mail and a Lot of Mail
papers I in sent wrote a
letter for Fernandez to the
Cornwall Standard put 1 Dollar
in it Mr Gene came to night
Fernandez and Seander went
with him to Fish Brought the
Bag of Salt Paid him 65
6th Fine Day Seander Fernandez
and Stanley Mowing and
making coils sent the letter
to the P Office with Gordon
Threshed the Beans the Drudge
into Salmon River the Steamer
Richie went Down her
East York here
