Fine sunny warm day. Willie took cream down in morning also chop to Clarks, he went down for chop after dinner 40 to get hand rake at Minnie 25 its collar mended at Wordens 10 its sugar paper 7 & 8, 125 We plowed in No 5 also took up potatoes in new orchard they are very poor crop. We put 10 roosters in coop in stable and 12 in coop we made out of organ box.

Wednesday

20 5 15

Misty morning and A.M. cleared off fine sunny P.M. I plowed out 4 rows potatoes in morning No 6. We plowed in No 5 and picked potatoes they are poor crop like all potatoes this year. Girls down town P.M. got meat at Bergins 50 its got hats at Russell on fr. We paid D Clark \$3.00 in full. I drove up to Armstrongs at night.

Fine sunny day cooler breezy. I plowed up 2 more rows potatoes in morning Willie picked and I plowed sod No 5. P.M. we both went to D Clarks thrashing. We finished picking the plowed out potatoes after thrashing, by moonlight. Mary down P.M. paid Arthur in full for teeth, mending my plate etc \$21.00 she got at F & S. shorts \$1.40 groceries & fruit \$2.70 to be sent up. I drove down at night for Mary.

Frost last night, fine sunny day very windy P.M. cool. C Quinn got wood straw P.M. for bedding went out on 3 Street We plowed in No 5 and took up rest of No 4 potatoes 3 more rows.
