30. Fine day, not so hot. 70/16 lbs sugar 1.00  
 1 pair cotton hose 20. Spool silk 5. lb stan<sup>10</sup> 35  
 4 yds brush binding 20. cream tartar 20 40  
 Finished cutting the outs. cost \$22.00 22.00  
 Had two men yesterday afternoon  
 shoveling the outs

31 Got a telegram from Pa. to meet Shirin  
 at Lancaster for the Moccasson  
 Monday put in four loads of outs  
 had Monday for the two rubber rings  
 he got at Proleters for me, 20 cts each 25

September 1900

- 1 Saturday. Fine morning. Birdie left for  
 Toronto. Marion drove her to Lancaster  
 Put in four loads of outs. had Pidgeon  
 half day
- 2 Very hot all day. Kate Roy, jr. took  
 dinner with us. Uncle Hugh an Aunt  
 Flora called.
- 3 Fine in forenoon. Afternoon turned very  
 windy. rained about 9 P.M. Got two  
 letters from Jimmie one to Marion. one  
 to me. Put in two loads outs
- 4 Put in four loads of outs in afternoon  
 Had Caritor. Camaron. 70 lb tea 25
- 5 Finished putting in what outs were cut
- 6 Woman's meeting did not take place  
 only Mrs. C. and myself. Mrs. Fress  
 came to the gate of Church and paid  
 Mrs. A. C. 50.00 for offerings in arrears  
 Put at M. C. 32 lbs sugar \$2.00  
 1 qt milk 15. 1 lb currants 7. Sold 25 eggs  
 on 3rd Sept. cost 13
- 7 Made plum jam. Baked. Marion came
- 8 Baked some pastry in home
- 9 Sunday. fine day
- 10 Birdie & Mable came in evening
- 11 Rain today
- 12 Birdie went to teach Libby's school  
 for a while Browns school. S. Branch)
- 13 Fine day. 15 qt tallow 15. (100 lb flour  
 in the 1 gal coal oil at M. C. 10.00)
- 14 Got a glass put-dish as prize  
 Baked 2 loaves. I had quite  
 a surprise. Was about McGillis of Port-  
 Arthur. and Mrs. John McGillis. R. R.  
 spent the evening with us. Alexis. I had  
 not seen for more than 20 years
