Victoria Day Wednesday 24th fine

Father cultivated root and Jimmie Chored & helped me hang two ^{series} gates, one west end west end of farm I took E. P. Queen down to Dorbys and tried her but she did not take. We also cleaned up rubbish around barn

Thursday 25th fine Showery evening

I took Queen and Princess to crosshill. to be bred to "Lord charming" expenses 50^c. I had a long dreary drive in the dark and got home about 11 P.M. Father and Jimmie Chored and sorted potatoes.
