 - 11 sowed 2 1/2 bushels of Rye when we summered
 fallow last summer in the North field sowed
 timothy & clover seed in the spring it ^{did not} take
 - 12 sowed 3 bushels of Rye in the North field south
 east half the grass seed did not take there much
 - 13 I went to Fairfax to S. P. Mr. Cornick to meet Sam
 Moonhead he did not come till near noon we walk
 to A. Cochran's got dinner went to all the members
 of the church to see what we could raise for a mission
 got home after dark had middling success
 - 14 heavy rain last night & this morning I went to
 young to see Betty She is some better
 - 15 Rev. Mr. Steward preached at night no Presbytery
 16 Ad began to plow in the North field south east half
 17 Ad plowed in the same field I sowed some peas for
 seed
