1/2 lb Powder 1/4 matches - 3 1/2 lb Tea 2/3 2 Spools Thread
1/6 Meal (1 lb 56 cents not sure) Maining George here and Pare
Bone 29th Mowing Back of the Barn Charlie Brought with
the Dog yesterday 30th adhering on the Lower Point Livinia Making
Raining this evening 31st Last Day of the month a very fine day
and much wanted turning the hay put in 8 Cocks had
mare in the cart the Putter got out a Letter for Charlie in
the P.O Lancaster Very Bad with the abominable Southwicks
1st of September Fired a shot at some Sivers did not
get them I can hear Luke Bowen singing and laughing on
at Alexis Island 2 sailboats backing over and across put in
some hay 2nd Lashey to Lancaster 3rd Sons Birth Day Mowing
4th fathering some and mowing a Bridge went to
in Yowky the America George Morris came to cut the
Pease Began the 2 Rows of Potatoes one for them and
one for us Put in 8 Cocks of Hay from Below 5 from the upper
field 5th John Angus Birth Day put in 6 Cocks of Hay
finished cutting the Pease Began the Wheat 6th finished
the Wheat cutting it put in a Load of Wheat George
I 7th George and I putting in Wheat 4 or 5 Loads Rain
commenced Took up a load of Wood from the River put in
Wheat on the east side or end of the Barn cut over 20 Sheaves
to take some for hats 8th George Went home Making a
Trench in the yard to let the water run off Maining
Sunday Lashey cropped George Rosell mowed the L Renaud
at Menahout's Bay
