Wed Jun 8th clear most of the day and hot
Victoria & I went to Thamesville
this fore noon, after noon Walter
and I went to Dresden for lumber

Thu Jun 9th cloudy most of the day and cool, we
were hoeing corn and potatoes, the air
feels like frost to night

Fri Jun 10th clear and pleasant, we were cul-
tivating and hoeing corn.

Sat Jun 11th clear and hot, Walter was culti-
vating corn, I was hoeing potatoes and
corn in the new Orchard.

Sun Jun 12th clear and pleasant

Mon Jun 13th clear part of the day and warm
we finished hoeing corn the first time over the
this fore noon, the rest of the day we were
mowing thistles

Tue Jun 14th clear and very hot, we were work-
ing at the corn part of the day, to hot.
this after noon to do much of any thing

Broton June 1887

Wed Jun 15th clear part of the day and hot, I was
mowing the grass and weeds about the
house and garden, Walter was cutting
thistles, William Butler here laying
the kitchen floor.

Thu Jun 16th clear most of the day and very hot
I took the wool to Thamesville and sold
it to Mr Huffman for 22 cent per lb
this after noon went over to the mill
for lumber

Fri Jun 17th clear most of the day and hot
we went over to the mill for lumber
this fore noon, after noon went to
Dresden for nails paint and lum-
ber, a thunder shower this evening

Sat Jun 18th cloudy part of the day and hot we
were hoeing potatoes most of the day
Butler shingling the kitchen

Sun Jun 19th clear part of the day and hot
