we cleaned out pens, J. unloaded saw dust fixed fence and run winder through corn and reed a little J. pulling bars & main bush

Tuesday 19th fine

J. finished bars & then pulled mustard. E.D. & J. fixed fence

Wednesday 20th fine

x I went down to Sorbys with Queen. Father to Lord C. then we worked at fence

Thursday 21st fine

we finished back fence and then put fence around a yard for side near barn

Friday 22nd wet

we chored & went to town
