- August 17 drew in 2 loads of oats that made 6 loads ^{out} of southwest half loads of wheat there was 118 stalks in fence ends.
- 18 rain this morning Wm & me helped Dick to draw in five loads of wheat by noon it was rather wet we cut oats in the afternoon & D came home this morning
- 19 Wm helped Bruce to draw in this forenoon & cut oats in the north east half of the north field
- 20 drew 4 loads of oats Wallace helped we had to Corbett's team & finished the cutting of that field
- 21 D helped Bruce to draw in this forenoon we drew in 3 loads of oats that is off except the rakes
- 22 the Rev W Dourley preached in the morning & Mr Stewart at night
- 23 cut the wheat at the old house the most of it a good crop Wallace helped D, Wm & him bin & I cut ~~the~~ with the reaper cut some oats in middle
- 24 Wm & me finished the oats in the middle ^{field} we mowed them with the scythe they were peas & oats I brack rivets in the cutting bar the reaper did not do as good work as we could do D helped Bruce
- 25 drew in 4 loads of peas & oats 3 of wheat & 1 load of ravings ~~some~~ Wallace helped I raked the peas & oat ground & the southwest part of the ^{new} field
- 26 Wm & D helped Bruce to draw in had our horses I fixed up the fences round the pea field & let the cows
- 27 began to hook the peas I hooked in the ⁱⁿ fence I could not stand it with my shoulder we cleaned out the well in the pit for the cows very worn day ^{He went to Gonaogou to see when they would go to Delbert}
- 28 Wm worked at the peas I went to Gonaogou with David him & Dave came from Delta last night
- 29 Rev W Stewart preached this morning W Dourley is not able to preach he is sick
- 30 drew in 3 loads of peas they are in good order & a good crop fine day D helped
- 31 Wm quite work on Saturday he wanted to go & rize up his thrasher
- 31 D & me hooked some peas in the forenoon him & Eliza went to young to bring Lennie home in the afternoon she is coming from Pembroke
