I took load straw to Smalls after tea and brought up load manure which we spread on No 5. W. Sindale helped me load it.

Wednesday

Fine sunny day cool. Willie took 2000 lbs oats to Curdiss @ 42 cts bushel \$24.00 brought at Memms oil 20 cts at Steels wheat 25 brought up load manure from Steels spread it on No 5 then brought up load wood from bush. I scuffled rest of turnips and some over again in A.M. in P.M. Willie continued scuffling and I hoed turnips and mangolds. Mary at W.F.M.S. in P.M. collection 5 cts rubbers at Phillips 8 cts.
