 May 27 sowed 1 Barrel of plaster in the field below the house where the fall wheat was last year began east side & sowed to the ridge straight before the house  
 Lock finished plowing the field front of Mr Glablin's  
 sowed 1 barrel of plaster on the second field began on the 10<sup>th</sup> ridge & sowed 9 ridges the other 4 was sowed in the season  
 28. Sowed 1 1/4 bushel of Barley at the foot of the field  
 the Revd Mr Smart preached in caintown this afternoon  
 29 Lock plowed for Rowson in the forenoon but dragged for him in the afternoon we chamed the corn & potato ground & began to plant the potatoes <sup>the potatoes that Lock got at the 5.5 & 7 is</sup>  
 30 finished planting the potatoes planted better then 25 & planted part of the corn Charles McCleary helped Washed the Sheep at J Sheughs  
 31 finished planting the corn planted 1 Bushel of potatoes that Father got from W<sup>m</sup> Warner part of the corn & part of the west side frost last night Lock went to help Robert McCleary with the team to plow  
 June 1 laid up some of the fence around the oats at <sup>the</sup> Crisplace Gonney went to Lyn with 25 butter tubs to John Mc Donald for J Clingham  
 2 split some rails for the West line Lock & John Armstrong Sheired the Sheep warm weather  
 3 made our part of the West line fence opposite Mc Enloshs Land  
 4 Mr John Keller preached in caintown  
 5 made part of the road fence at Crisplace  
 6 bored & made 40 caps & scills for the fence on Crisplace  
 7 put Legs & Bel Maires to Alfred Arnee horse to give him 9 of the three manes has fokes and dos well to give him six dollars of it in time for home to go up the country made more of the fence  
 8 finished the fence this morning heavy rain last night moved part of the fence on this side of the sugar bush
