Treatment of Surgical Shock.

In emergency cases Crile advises administering adrenalin by lowering the head and then filling the nostrils with 30 minims of the solution, dropping two minims at a time and taking sixty seconds to give the whole dose. Other surgeons have found this a very good method, the effect lasting much longer than when it is given hypodermically. Adrenalin raises the blood-pressure at once, and by following it with drugs which have a stimulating action upon the vessels and the heart muscle the pressure is kept up, allowing the vaso-motor center to recover from its exhaustion and resume its normal function.—Wells; Int. Journ. of Surg.
